Cullercoats Collective are currently recruiting members of the local community to provide a warm welcome to the village and bay on warm, sunny days at the coast.

We are looking for friendly, welcoming individuals to greet visitors at key arrival points. You'll provide information on local businesses and services and promote the village's cultural calendar. In addition, you'll assist with keeping the community safe and presentable, liaising with the authorities if you notice anything of concern. Most importantly, you'll be working as part of a friendly and enthusiastic team striving to promote Cullercoats as a great place to live, work and play.

Duties

- Welcoming visitors to Cullercoats at key access points, typically the north and south beach access ramps and the shops around Victoria Crescent.
- Offering advice to visitors on things to do, and signposting to local businesses and services within the community.
- Providing a friendly face to represent the community of Cullercoats, to help engage visitors positively with key
 messages around keeping the community clean and safe for all.
- Directly assisting with keeping the community clean and tidy, engaging in litter picking and occasional light gardening/planting.
- Occasionally liaising with the Police, Nexus and/or North Tyneside Council if issues arise within the community, so these agencies can provide an appropriate response.
- Participating in quarterly catch up with Cullercoats Collective to help improve the ambassador programme.
